Dear Secretary.

As you are aware that to strengthen resolution of commercial disputes as well as to boost institutional arbitration in the country, the Parliament has amended the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 in 2015 and again in 2019. Further, New Delhi International Arbitration Centre Act, 2019 has also been passed.

2. In this regard, the details of the cases in which Government Departments/Autonomous bodies/CPSEs and Statutory bodies are involved in arbitral proceedings needs to be consolidated to have an assessment of the sum locked in disputes and know the total number of such cases pending consideration at various stages. The same is further required to assess the impact of legislative changes made on strengthening of arbitration eco-system in the country.
